

Veterinary Activities

Beside regular veterinary care and management following diagnostic and therapeutic measures were executed during this period.

- Successful closed method castration of 1 no Nilgai under chemical immobilization.
- X-ray and abdominal ultrasonography of a male leopard for diagnostic purpose.
- Morphometric analysis of newly arrived tapir at the zoo.
- Installation of digital X-ray machine, 5 parts automatic hematology analyzer, Automatic bio-chemistry analyzer, urine analyzer, Electrolyte analyzer at renovated zoo veterinary hospital laboratory for disease diagnosis of zoo animals.
- Zoo veterinary team visited Digha and Baguran Jalpai sea shore in Purba Medinipur District for health monitoring of Olive ridley turtles and Irawadi dolphins.
- Conducted Internship training programme of 5th Yr. BVSC&AH students of WBUAFS, Kolkata





- One Brow-antler Deer fawn was born on 28th January, 2024.


Success story of captive breeding

- II. Three Spotted Deer fawns were observed in 5th January, 2nd February and 1st March, 2024.
- III. Three Black Vulture Chick's were observed on 10th, 22nd and 24th February, 2024.
- IV. One Domestic Goose was observed on 21st, two observed on 23rd and one was observed on 26th February, 2024.
- V. On 28th February, 2024 one porcupette was observed.


From the Report of the Zoological Garden, Alipore, Management Committee 1923-24

In the year 1923-1924, the Committee of the Management of the Zoological Garden, was supervised by the

- 1) Hon'ble President, Mr. Justice P.L. Buckland,
- 2) Hon'ble Vice-President, Sir Bijay Chand Mahtab, and
- 3) Superintendent, Rai Bijay Krishna Basu Bahadur.

Not only the elite-class people but ordinary visitors too including school children, stopped by the Garden throughout the year and enjoyed the easy view of diverse animals and birds.

- i. Usually, the Garden received an average footfall of 2404 visitors daily, except for special occasions like the "Fancy Fair" when it outstretched to 10,260 people.
- ii. On Tuesday afternoons, the 90th Punjabi Regiment Band play (free of charge) added an extra amusement to the Garden.
- iii. Monthly, one Monday was announced as a "free day" when the entry fee remained fully waived.
- iv. The entry fee being only Seven paise per head, the Annual report portrays that "the financial condition of the Garden is on the whole satisfactory". Part of this profit was reinvested for the Garden upgrade.



New addition to the garden:

- a. In 1924, a new entrance gate was constructed on the Orphanage Road, keeping the tram line nearby and thus making it more convenient for the zoo entry.
- b. A new Carnivora house was also constructed to house large felids in the Garden. This enclosure was modernized by keeping an open-air arena simulating their natural foraging ground, whereas the closed dens were restructured with grillage windows and wooden platforms to maximize ventilation.
- c. A night-watch was appointed for the first time to secure the entire Garden area throughout the day-night sessions.

The first exhibition of Chimpanzee:

For the first time, in the year 1923-1924, the Garden received a Chimpanzee from the Zoological Society of Scotland.



"The most important addition to the collection during the year was a Chimpanzee sent by the Zoological Society of Scotland. This species has never before been exhibited and is a great attraction to visitors"

(Ref: Report of Hony. Committee for Management, 1923:24) Overcoming an Epidemic:

In 1923, the cattle plague, "Rinderpest" broke out among Gayals. The epidemic was successfully controlled by the cooperative efforts being made by the officers and staff of the Bengal Veterinary College, and the Calcutta School of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene.
